The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements set in forth in the Act on Higher Education of July 20, 2018 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws 2018, item 1668, as amended)

The candidate should have a PhD in economic sciences, demonstrate scientific achievements in the field of quantitative finance and at least several years of experience in teaching classes (in Polish and English) in the field of modeling time series, practical application of predictive models, and testing investment strategies. The candidate is also expected to know advanced financial data analysis methods, and the ability to perform advanced analyzes of large volumes of high-frequency financial data will be an additional advantage. He should also have experience in the field of quantitative finance research, documented in English language publications in international scientific journals. The habilitation application in the field of finance will be an additional advantage of the potential candidate. It is also advisable to have a documented stay on foreign internships related to scientific work.
